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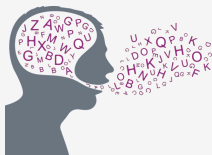


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Communication is a cornerstone of human relationships. When an individual struggles to verbalize information, thoughts, and feelings, it can cause major barriers in personal, learning, and business interactions.

Any condition that affects a person's capacity to produce sounds that form words is referred to as a speech disorder. Delayed speech is the commonest abnormality and is present in 47.8%, defective articulation in 21.6%, stuttering in 15.6%, multiple speech defects in 10.8%, rhinolalia in 2.1% and aphasia in 1.9% of cases.



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This course will give students the theoretical and clinical information need to provide services to children with speech sound disorders, including articulation and phonological delays, residual speech sound errors, and speech sound disorders associated with childhood apraxia of speech as well as with structural and motor deficits
