#### HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY

Samarkand State University has played the invaluable role in the international recognition of Samarkand science and culture. Today SamSU is one of the oldest and largest higher education institutions in Central Asia, and although it has been officially operating since the beginning of the XXth century, its historical roots go back to the times of Mirzo Ulugbek (XVth century). During the reign of the Timurids, who were the promoters of science, spirituality and enlightenment, a solid ground for the development of science and education was created in the territory north of Amu Darya, and in particular in the city of Samarkand. A number of madrassas built by Sahibkiran Amir Temur, his children and grandchildren were places of enlightenment that provided religious and secular knowledge. In particular, the scientific school created by Muhammad Taragay Ulugbek, the pride of Uzbek science, and the greatness of its potential is recognized today by the scientists across the world. Mirzo Ulugbek madrasah in Registan Square is undoubtedly the "cradle" of Samarkand higher education, its organizational basis and foundation.

Abdurahmon Jami, Alisher Navoi, Ali Kushchi, Mavlono Nafis Samarkandi, Badakhshi studied in this "Alma-mater" and later taught science. Representatives of Mirzo Ulugbek's astronomical school Giyosiddin Kashi, Jamshid ibn Masud, Qazizoda Rumi, Ali Kushchi, Muhammad Khawafi taught secular sciences such as mathematics, astronomy, basics of calculation and geography at that madrasa.

Thus, the roots of Samarkand State University go back to the times of Mirzo Ulugbek.

The authoritative literary scholar, academician Boturkhon Valikhodjaev, in his book "The Madrasahs of the times of Mirzo Ulugbek", comes to the scientific conclusion that Samarkand State University is the direct secular successor of Mirzo Ulugbek Madrasah, and the history of its establishment dates back to the history of Mirzo Ulugbek Madrasah (1420 AD).

In these early years, Samarkand State university had departments of sociopolitical sciences, physics, engineering, natural sciences, and philology. Based on this university, Samarkand's Agricultural, Medical, Services, and Foreign language institutes grew into independent universities.

The current development and history of our higher education institution at different times is directly related to the activities of Merkulovich, K. Abdullaev, A. Valiev, H. Fayzullaev, M. Muminov, R. Olimjonov, K. Zokirov, A. Tulaganov, V. Abdullaev, E. Turakulov, A. Otakhuzhayev, Sh. Alimov, M. Zhurakulov, T. Muminov, J. Sattorov, T. Shirinov, O. Khalmukhamedov and R. Khalmuradov.

About 30 000 undergraduate and graduate students are studying at the university in more than 39 fields of study. They include more than 82 doctors and professors. More than 420 candidates of sciences and associate professors, more than 1000 professors and teachers teach in Uzbek, Russian and Tajik languages at SamSU.

#### FACULTY PHYSICS

Since the establishment of the Uzbek State University in 1927, the Faculty of Physics and Mathematics has begun its function. For the first time in 1933, scientist, prof. A.M. Titov from Russia was invited to work in physics department in Samarkand and together with A.Yu.Pedder and N.P.Kuznetsov the chair "General Physics" in 1933, the chair "Optics and theoretical physics" were created in 1935.

According to the results of long years of research in the faculty, there were 4 scientific schools have been created. 1. "Optics" (Founder and Academician A.K.Otaxujayev), 2. Nuclear Physics (Founder Prof. Muso Muminov), 3. "Magnetism" (Founder and Professor O. Kuvondikov), 4. Space Physics and Astrophysics (Founder and the head of the department is Professor B.Mahmudov).

In addition, 2 separate directions were separated and developed from the Optical Science School. Nonlinear optical direction (Scientific adviser prof.L.M.Sobirov) and direction of Molecular luminesology (Scientific supervisor prof.N.Nizomov).

Currently, the Faculty of Physics has 5 departments: optics, general physics (head of the department associate professor Z. Shodiev), theoretical physics and quantum electronics (head of the department prof. N. Eshkobilov), solid state physics (Head of the Department, Associate Professor S. Akhrorov), Nuclear Physics and Astronomy (Head of the Department, Associate Professor R. M. Eshboriev).

#### **BIOLOGY FACULTY**

The Faculty of Biology was founded in 1927, on the basis of which it was reorganized again on 24 August 2018.

The Faculty of Biology has 66 employees. Among them 7 Doctors of Science (10.60%), 37 Candidates of Science, Associate Professors (56.06%) and 22 Assistants without academic degrees (33, 33%). The scientific potential at the faculty is 71.4%.

The scientific schools existing at the faculty in the field of Botany, Plant Physiology, Zoology, Biochemistry and Genetics carry out scientific research begun by the founders of these schools and continued by their students in the study and analysis of the systematic, biochemical, physiological, genetic and biotechnological characteristics of flora and fauna of the Zarafshan Valley, as well as the introduction of methods of their rational use into production.

The faculty has a Zoological Museum, which includes more than 40,000 exhibits, a Greenhouse, growing more than 10,000 specimens of 250 plant species, the Herbarium fund, including more than a thousand plant specimens, an entomological collection covering almost all insect species of the local fauna, as well as educational modern laboratories equipped with the latest equipment.

# **Uzbekistan-Finland Pedagogical Institute**

Uzbekistan-Finland Pedagogical Institute of Samarkand State University named after Sharof Rashidov was established on June 30, 2021 by the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan by the No. 408. One of the main tasks of the institute is to train personnel with higher professional education in the field of pedagogy, the ability to use modern pedagogical technologies in the educational process. The educational process at the university is organized on the basis of Finnish educational programs and technologies. Based on the peculiarities of the national character of the Uzbek people, the institute aims to train quality teachers on the basis of advanced educational technologies, such as caring for the younger generation, striving to bring up a healthy, harmoniously developed person.

# Samarkand State University named after Sharof Rashidov Kattakurgan branch

Samarkand State University named after Sharof Rashidov Kattakurgan branch was established by the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan by No 307 on May 18, 2021. Currently, the branch has 716 students studying in 11 areas. The educational institution has 2 faculties (Business Administration and Information Technology, Pedagogy and Language Teaching) and 4 departments (Humanities, Preschool Education and Pedagogy, Information Technology, Business Administration). The branch had 49 professors and teachers, including 2 doctors of sciences, 9 candidates of sciences and doctors of philosophy. The scientific potential of the branch today is 22%.

In order to create conditions for the research work of gifted students in 17 circles operating at the departments under the guidance of professors and teachers of the branch are involved in scientific work, preparing for international and national science Olympiads.

## Institute of Entrepreneurship and Pedagogy Denau branch

Denau Institute of Entrepreneurship and Pedagogy was established by the Degree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PQ – 4681 on April 17, "On measures to expand and further improve the system of training highly qualified personnel in Surkhandarya region.

# **Scientific Library**

The Scientific Library of Samarkand State University is one of the biggest scientific and information centers in the Republic of Uzbekistan with a large collection of books. The library stores publications of the peoples of the CIS, foreign literature, manuscripts and other materials. It is also one of the largest places where the masterpieces of ancient and world culture are preserved. The library has a multidisciplinary fund, which contains information collected over many years. The library contains information published on various topics in world languages. Its foundation is perfect in every way.

An important place in the library is occupied by the section of rare books published before 1917. This section contains about 14,500 copies of Russian-language literature and about 1,000 copies of foreignlanguage literature. This section contains literature and a variety of materials on history, archeology, ethnography, literature, linguistics, philosophy, ethics, logic, religion, natural and exact sciences. This section contains a wide variety of literature books.

# ZOOLOGY MUSEUM

In 1934, the S.K. Dallar and K.K. Dallar founded Zoology museum. More than 3,000 exhibits, exhibits with a history of more than 100 years. The museum has examples of Turan tigers (in the Red Book of Uzbekistan since 1954), Indian elephant, Bukhara deer, gazelle, spotted gazelle, black and brown bears, snow leopards, wild pigs, the rarest Turkmen eublefars in the Red Book of Uzbekistan, the gray goat, one of the best fur-bearing animals of Uzbekistan: beaver, Central Asian fox, specimens of the American crocodile, white-headed sandpiper, squirrel, white-tailed water eagle, black-and-white eagle, Indian peacock, several species of Zarafshan pheasants, red goose, white storks, black storks, white and gray storks.

Samarkand State University has a rich tradition of archaeological research. The scientists who initiated this movement were led by the enterprising professor D.N. Lev and academician Ya. Gulyamov. As a result of this scientific activity, more than 100 archeological monuments of different historical periods have been found and studied in the Zarafshan oasis alone. And as a result, more than 40,000,000 unique scientific sources have been obtained. Museum staff will be working on researching the sources as well as conducting field research.

#### PALEONTOLOGY MUSEUM

Paleontology museum at the Faculty of Geography of SamSU was founded in the mid-1930s by geologists and geographers. Practical parts of lessons on geology, geomorphology, use of natural resources are taught to students directly on the basis of museum materials. The Alisher Navoi Museum was established in 1991 and was renovated in 2014. The "Scientific Center for the Study of Alisher Navoi's Creative Heritage" has been opened at the museum.

# **ARCHEOLOGY MUSEUM**

The Museum of Archeology has been operating since 1965. The museum has a great historical and artistic value, consisting of more than 65,000 artifacts from the Muste period (90-70 thousand years BC) to the XII century, is important not only for the history of our country, but also for the history of Central Asia There are archeological collections.

The museum is a place for educational and laboratory activities. There is a circle "Archeology, ethnography, ancient history" at the museum. In the scientific processing of materials prof. Avenesova N.A. students are also participating. The scientific observations here also form the basis of their course and diploma work.

The Faculty of History was established in 2001 on the basis of the Museum of Archeology (1969), as a result of research work since 1947, the Archaeological Training and Production Laboratory. In the process of stationary and research study of the material of primitive cultural monuments between the rivers of Central Asia.

The laboratory funds contain more than 50,000 valuable scientific, historical and artistic archeological collections on the history of Uzbekistan. They reflect the historical chronicle of the region in almost all periods - from the Muste period (80-40 thousand years BC) to the beginning of the 1st millennium BC. e. (Bronze Age). In addition, the expositions feature interesting exhibits from the 9th to 11th centuries. n. e. According to the excavations of the Afrosiyab settlement, from the history of our city.



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# SCIENTIFIC-PRACTICAL MUSEUM-LABORATORY NAMED AFTER ALSIHER NAVOI

The Scientific and Practical Museum-Laboratory of SamSU was organized on the basis of the Alisher Navoi Museum, which was established in 1996 under the Khokimyat of the city of Samarkand, according to the decision of the Scientific Council of the University. The museum, on the initiative of the administration of SamSU (U.Tashkenbaev), with the financial support of the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan, was reconstructed and a new exposition was created on the basis of a new project, which was opened on September 8, 2014.

In addition to the main exhibition hall, the museum has a conference hall for 60 seats, a computer room for practical exercises, a room for storing museum items, office rooms for employees. The exposition halls and service premises of the museum are equipped with modern information technology equipment.

The new twenty-first century entered the history of mankind as an intellectual age, and in this century, the training of highly qualified personnel and specialists will remain one of the main goals and objectives of Samarkand State University.

The museum is working in the research and scientific-methodical direction. For example, the study of the life and creative work of Alisher Navoi, the history of education in the East, the history of SamSU, the cultural heritage of the Samarkand region, museology and other areas.



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
