Does your university as a body support and/or organise events aimed to promote conservation and sustainable utiutilization the land, including forests and wild land?

Samarkand State University has owned a Botanical Garden, just outskirts of the city which is being used for learning, teaching, and research purpose. Different faculties and departments of Samarkand State University bring here their undergraduate, postgraduate, Ph.D. students, and faculty members for teaching and research. Specially, Faulty of Agrobiotechnology, Biology and Faculty of Geography and Ecology are having more interest for developing such a biodiverse zone.

Dr. Akbar Akhmedov, Associate Professor, Department of Botany Samarkand State University visited botanical garden with students for teaching them biodiversity and its importance in order to achieve sustainable development of land resources.

During this field work, undergraduate students of faculty of agrobiotechnology also participated and knew about available agriculture activities and allied techniques which are being used here for cultivation of different fruits like apples, berries, oranges and many other grains.

After attending this valuable session, students have prepared herbarium files in order to complete practical work.
