This conference was aimed to establish an inclusive information which can be further transferred among new generations.




Many foreign academicians have participated in the conference and put forward their opinions about the necessity of such conferences for the betterment of intercultural relations.

It was attended by a group of professors, teachers and students led by Professor Li Qi from Shaanxi Normal University, China and Vice-Rector for international relations Mukhtar Nosirov, associate professor B. Ergashev, basic doctoral student N. Khushvaktov and others.

Under cooperation program, an international scientific-practical conference on the topic of "Critical problems of ecology and nature use" was launched at Samarkand State University.
