Does your university as a body have a policy commitment against forced labour, modern slavery, human trafficking, and child labour?

The Republic of Uzbekistan is a leading player in the worldwide campaign against human trafficking, forced labor and child labor etc. In the Central Asian Region, Uzbekistan is making significant efforts against these inhuman activities. Uzbekistan laws inhibit human trafficking including all forms of sexual exploitation, and engaging others in prostitution, servitude, forced labor, organ trafficking, coerced service, enslavement, begging and quasi-slavery practices.

National and State level committees are working on preventing and reducing such crimes in the country. In order to achieve the national and international interest, Samarkand State University organized a dialogue about Crime Among Young People, Human Trafficking and Prevention of Unpleasant Situations which was held at the Faculty of History.
