COURSE OBJECTIVES:

This course will cover necessary information on academic writing skills, data selection, data preparation and presentation in such a manner that can be accepted by any of the journals internationally. It focuses young teachers, scientists, researchers and academicians involved in teaching and research at universities, institutes and other departments.

Topics:

1. Critical components of academic writing for publications.
2. Collection of data, their technical analysis and preparation.
3. Best practices for making research proposals and research articles.
4. Identification of emerging topics of research in different disciplines.
5. Analysis of Scopus, SCI, Web of Science indexed journals for understanding submission, review and duration of publication.

Methodology:

This seminar will be conducted online and will include the delivery of instructions, presentations, data preparation methods, discussions and question- answer sessions.

Course Duration:

This course will be conducted between 5th & 6th October 2022 from Samarkand State University. Three lectures will be delivered every day from speakers and one lecture will be of 60 minutes (45 Minutes Presentation & 15 Minutes, discussion, Q&A). Participants of Samarkand State University will join this seminar in offline or online both while other participants will join this seminar through an online link, will be provided at least 2-3 days before actual event.
